ADMISSION CRITERIA

B. Pharmacy degree examination of an Indian University established by law in India from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55% of the maximum marks (aggregate of four years of B. Pharmacy). Provided that -

- There shall be reservation of seats for the students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government/State Government/Union Territory Administration, as the case may be, from time to time.
- For SC/ST candidates the prescribed percentage of marks will be 50% of the maximum marks (aggregate of four years of B. Pharmacy).
- Every student, selected for admission to postgraduate pharmacy course in any of the pharmacy institution in the country should have obtained Registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.
- The admission is based on GPAT/ PGCET/ PIO/ FN/ Management categories and is subjected reservation policy of the government from time to time.

Semesters	: 4 semesters (each semester will be not less than 20 week including examinations provided the academic calendar structured to fulfil 90 instruction days excluding examinations).
